Candidate Frequently Asked Questions:

- How do I get my name on the ballot?

 File with the City Secretary form AW2-21 (enclosed) within the filing period.
- What places are on the ballot for the May 3, 2025 election and how long are the terms? Three (3) Council seats with Two (2) year terms.
- Does it cost money to run for City Council?
 No.
- <u>Is being a council member or mayor a full-time job? Do I get paid?</u>
 No, service on the City Council is not a full-time job, however Council meeting requirements do exist. Serving on the City Council is not a paid position.
- How often does council meet, where and what time?

 City Council regular meetings are held on the 2nd Monday of each month. They are held at Reno City Hall in the Council chambers and normally begin at 6:00 p.m. There are several times during the year that special meetings are held, usually on an as needed basis.
- As a candidate for City Council with whom and where do I file my paperwork?

 All required paperwork is filed with the City Secretary. Please remember it is each candidate's responsibility to meet all required deadlines. Check your calendar and packet information often.
- Where can I place political signs? When can I begin to put up political signs?
